This is a message to the Open Network network of YouthNetworks.

Youth center Zavod O from Slovenia is looking for 3 EVS volunteers to apply on 1. April. Zavod O is youth center organization in town Škofja Loka, Slovenia. Youth activities of Zavod O are well established in local environment of Škofja Loka. Organization is composed of 3 units: Multimedia center Pulsar, youth club Pri rdeči ostrigi and Art unit Atelje CLOBB. Basic activities of units are well established:

MMC Pulsar: Multimedia center with 11 computers, free access to Internet, computer classroom. MMC has regular working hours from Monday till Friday. Possibilities for EVS volunteer activities: making a short movies (funny movie for each year student freshman's party, other prominent events ...), work in computing (web pages), graphic design of PR material (leaflets, posters ...), help to administrators ...

MKC Pri rdeči ostrigi: Club runs a program 5 days per week during the school year. We have regular events – Fridays and Saturdays are meant for concerts and parties, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Sundays for lectures, movies, debate clubs, social game events (poker, Catan ...). Possible activities for EVS volunteer: organizing and participating in program of youth centre, maintenance of the place, technical support with sound system, lights.

Art center Atelje CLOBB: It is daily used for art, graphic and photographic youth activities. We organize all kinds of art workshops for children, youth and grown-ups. Activists are active within all major events and are also the leading unit in organizing few public events per year – events taking place on Main Square of the town.

We are looking for 3 volunteers. Two of them will be working in youth center Zavod O and one in Daily center for youth and children (unit of public institution Social center in Škofja Loka). Volunteers will share a flat but have their own room.

Project 1 and 2 (1.9 2010 – 28.2.2011, 6 months – flexible and 20.8. 2010 – 20.7.2011, 11 months - flexible):

Volunteer will get to know Zavod O organization, activities, activists, local environment. Volunteer will be included in Zavod O regular activities in Youth centre Pri rdeči ostrigi, Multimedia centre Pulsar and Atelje CLOBB. Detailed program will be made according to



volunteer knowledge and interests.

Zavod O has a many different activities volunteer can participate. Detailed program will be defined through communication with volunteers. Possible activities:

- Video production
- Multimedia production
- design and programming English web-page of Zavod O activities
- Maintaining computer network
- Help with graphic design of posters, leaflets
- Help with maintaining premises of Youth club Pri rdeči ostrigi
- Creation for scene decoration in Ostriga events.
- Preparing events presenting his culture (movie events, cultural events) once a month during the project
- Help in the implementation of different workshop (for children, with professional, with social center,...)
- Take part in the organization of our big events such as Mesto V Barvah festival (town in colors) and Dan za Strpnost (tolerance day)
- Creating a project on his own, bringing new ideas

Daily center for Children and Youth DC Ω (unit of Center for social work Škofja Loka):

Zavod O is also coordinating organization for EVS project for hosting organization Center for Children and Youth DC Ω (unit of Center for social work Škofja Loka). Center is opened for children from Monday till Friday from 11.00 till 19.00. Volunteer will get to know both – hosting and coordinating organization, activities, activists, local environment. Activities prepared for volunteer: participating on workshops for children, help with organization of activities.

Diaconat Protestant - Residence Rochecolombe is searching for partners in hosting youth exchange.

Who we are



The Residence Rochecolombe creates conditions so that the young people that it welcomes build their first steps in the active life.

Using a global approach, the residence acts on all the control levers which contribute to the development of the young people :reception, housing environment, employment, training, health, cultural opening, citizenship and their creative involvement where they live.

The population : They are native of France, DOM-TOM, European Union and foreign countries. (Asia, Africa and Latin America)They are salaried, job-hunters, trainees of the vocational training, or students.

Our work: They all have different needs according to age, French language level and the knowledge of the social and professional environment. A multidisciplinary team of 5 social workers and 1 European Volunteer intervenes in the various domains of everyday life (health, budget, employment, training, accommodation, leisure activities...) The coordinator makes a social accompaniment individual for the search of job and training, he also has a responsibility for the conception and the application of collective actions which aim at facilitating the links between residents, the consideration of the cultural differences and the socialization within our community

Main Topic - Objectives and Aim



Our Main aim to unite young people on the debates regarding chosen topics like immigration, xenophobia, racism, social inclusion-adaptation.

Creating connections between participants, local people and immigrants; Giving a chance to compare their conditions with others in a moderated atmosphere.

We would like to encourage them to presenting their own immigrant situations in their countries and personal aspects, experiences, problems and will be discussed at the project.

Lead them to finding solutions of problems which foreign people faced in their life and find common ground the way of solution and promote them after the project.

One of our goal is to make clear minds on decision making phase we will try to make minds without prejudices on immigrants or foreign people and take a step through costs of xenophobia.

Residence Rochecolombe's status causes local people and foreigners to live together in the same roof so that participants will have a chance to meet with foreigners, immigrants and people who came for their education. It is important for us to involve the residence in our project; in this way, participants will be able to talk with people with different cultural backgrounds. Besides that, the Residence has its own regular social activities allowing participants to join in different activities.

Preparation

Every Team has to prepare presentation before project. We would like to give 45mins-1hour to each team for present situation of immigrants in their countries with examples or critical crises.(videos and pictures are more welcome in presentation which are about topics)

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- Immigration Rates , Immigrant's Situation in general terms
 - Adaptation period of immigrants and/or foreign people and associations which deals with them
 - Fighting against xenophobia and social activities which fight against it
 - Racism, solution ways, experiences and ideas
 - Religion effects on immigrants
 - Social Inclusion, social activities for inclusion
 - Discrimination, Priority or Restriction
 - Gender equality of immigrants and their unemployment status, associations which helps them to find suitable job
 - Problems between different Immigrant in the same area
- Preparation for Intercultural Night
Be ready to present your country and your culture in the Intercultural Evening

Requirements: Interest and high motivation in working with children (6-12 years), basic German, if possible experiences with children- or youthwork.

Project description:

And other similar after school clubs:

The After-School-Clubs are based on the premises of the primary schools. They open at 11 o'clock. The children go there after class and get a warm lunch. Afterwards they do their homework and participate in different workshops such as music, theatre, gardening, sports... The volunteer will work from Monday till Friday from 11- 16.00. In the evening she



or he will attend German classes.

Tasks: help in the workshops run for the children, help during lunch, looking after the children, help with homework, help running the holiday programs, it really depends on the volunteers interests.

Requirements: Basic German would be good, interest in working with children, if possible experiences with children- or youth work. The volunteer should stay for one year which means from August 2010 until July 2011.

It is important that you like working with children of that age group (6 and 10 years). You would also eat in the project – with the kids. The centre is open during school times. You will be asked to take your vacation during the school breaks at Christmas, Easter, six weeks in Summer and two weeks in October.

Accommodation:

Your accommodation is a Catholic monastery, called Don Bosco in the middle of Muelheim which is a district on the right side of the river in Cologne. Muelheim is not located in the city center, but it offers a wide choice of shopping possibilities. The monastery is a five minute walk from the tram station.

The volunteers don't have to be Christian or follow any Christian traditions in the monetary.

The Salesianer monks are a Catholic order, you can find them in the internet:

www.salesianer.de. The focus of the monks is charity work: In Muelheim they run the biggest Youth Centre of Cologne. The volunteers have got their own room on the guest floor (one for girls, one for boys) together with the other volunteers, a bathroom with laundry facilities and a kitchen. The volunteers have access to almost all parts of the monastery as there are lounges with TV and Video, a living room, a library and a beautiful garden. They get their own keys and are able to leave the house whenever they want to. They are not in the responsibility of the monks, but they must tolerate their way of living and behave with respect. It is allowed for them to have visitors until 10pm. If e.g. family members like to stay overnight, they can ask in advance, to rent a room for 10,- € a night. The volunteers should always keep the noise down. They are not allowed to have visitors overnight. The volunteer has to clean his own room and the rooms that he shares (kitchen). We will provide your room with some furniture such as bed, wardrobe, table and chair. In addition we provide plates, cups, glasses, cutlery, bedding, sheets, towels, a pot and a pan. You always have to clean your room yourself. Your accommodation must be clean when you leave. We might ask you to pay a deposit which you get back after your stay. We do not pay phone bills. The volunteers have to pay themselves for a mobile phone.

Monthly Allowance:

You will receive 105 € pocket money and a food allowance according to the sums specified by the national agency.

Local Travel:

We provide a monthly travel card for you. It allows you to use public transport in Cologne. The national agency pays the train tickets to the seminars and back.



Seminars:

During your EVS you have to attend two seminars in Germany. The on-arrival training will be during your first three months. The midterm-meeting will take place in the middle of the year. They are run by the national agency. You will have monthly meetings with the Mentor and the other volunteers.

Working hours:

Volunteers work approx. 35 hours a week, normally from Monday to Friday including language training. According to the project you will be asked to also to work the weekend. You work a maximum of two days a month at the weekend, but you will have another day off instead.

Language training:

We provide you with language courses. IN VIA pays the course and the school book. You do not have to go to language school if your German is good enough to support and work in the project.

Holidays:

For each month that you work with us, you get two days off. If you work in the After School Club you have fixed holidays according to the closing times due to school holidays. Therefore you have only maybe 2 days for your own choice.
